## **TERMS OF REFERENCE HAI HELICOPTER TOUR OPERATORS COMMITTEE**

### **OBJECTIVE**

In accordance with the policies and procedures of the Association, the Helicopter Tour Operators Committee (HTOC) is established to monitor and review safety, regulatory, and legislative/political issues with potential impact on the helicopter tour industry, make recommendations to the HAI Board regarding these issues, provide relevant information to helicopter tour operators, and work with other HAI Committees to address issues that directly impact the helicopter industry. The Helicopter Tour Operators Committee serves at the pleasure of the HAI Board of Directors and, as such, will act on behalf of the entire HAI membership as directed by the HAI Board.

### **GUIDANCE MATERIALS**

In all circumstances, efforts and actions of the Committee shall be conducted in accordance with the HAI Committee Guidelines and Procedures Manual.

All Committee activity shall be conducted with full knowledge of, and close adherence to, the HAI Antitrust Compliance Guidelines.

### **MEMBERSHIP**

Number of Members: The Helicopter Tour Operators Committee shall have at least five (5) voting members, but not more than 25 members. The Chairperson, Vice Chairperson and Secretary plus a maximum of 22 voting members will constitute the total membership of the HTOC.

### **AMENDMENT OF TERMS OF REFERENCE**

Upon a majority vote of the Committee, the Committee Chairperson, with the advice and consent of the Board Liaison and the Board Vice Chairman, may make application to the HAI Board of Directors through the Corporate Secretary for a change to the Terms of Reference.
